LEGAL HELP NOW

- **Legal Aid Society of Hawai'i:** 1-800-499-4302. Lines are open Monday through Friday, 9-11:30am and 1-3:30pm. Legal Aid is a non-profit legal organization.

INSURANCE



- **MEDQUEST:** Provides insurance for low-income people under 65 and families. Apply at benefits.hawaii.gov/applying-for-benefits/
- **MARKETPLACE:** For people who are not eligible for MedQuest. Apply within 60 days of losing your job at healthcare.gov

PUBLIC ASSISTANCE



- **GENERAL ASSISTANCE:** \$348 per month. For people who are temporarily disabled, low income, with no kids. This application is the same as the SNAP application. Email the dual application at <https://humanservices.hawaii.gov/bessd/1961-2/> to bessd.statewidebranch@dhs.hawaii.gov
- **SNAP (FOOD STAMPS):** Money for food loaded on a card. This application is the same as the General Assistance. See above for application process.
- **TANF/TAONF:** For low-income parents with kids under 18. This application is the same as SNAP and General Assistance. See above for application process.
- **UNEMPLOYMENT:** For recently unemployed or struggling freelancers. Apply at huiclaims.hawaii.gov or call (808) 762-5725.
- **CHILDCARE:** Cash payments for low-income families with children. Visit humanservices.hawaii.gov/bessd/ccch-subsidies/ for how to apply

HOUSING



- **UTILITY HELP:** LIHEAP can give one-time help for utility bills. To apply, call HCEOC at (808) 961-2681 ext. 108.
- **EVICTION:** Evictions are temporarily on hold until 6/30. Some protections available until 7/26.
- **RENT HELP:** One-time rent help is available. Call 211.
- **OTHER:** If you are being evicted, if you have been locked out of your home, if you need a shelter, or for other housing questions, call Legal Aid at 1-800-499-4302.
